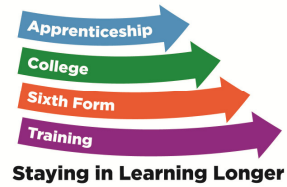


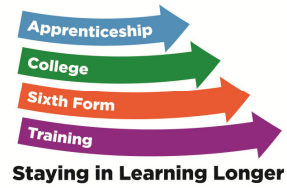

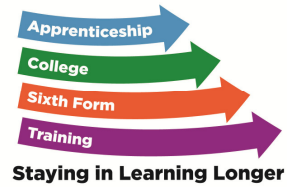

Staying in Learning Longer

- Put simply young people are required to stay in learning for longer
- All young people are now required to stay 'In Learning' until their 18th birthday
- The school leaving age has not changed

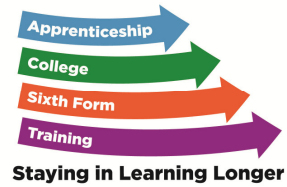


Qualification levels

Qualification framework has 6 levels:

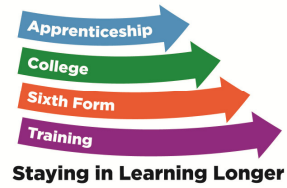
- Entry level – eg Skills for Life, Foundation Learning
- Level 1 – GCSE grades D-G, BTEC Intro Diploma
- Level 2 – 5 x GCSEs grade A*-C, BTEC First
- Level 3 – A level, IB, BTEC Level 3 Diploma

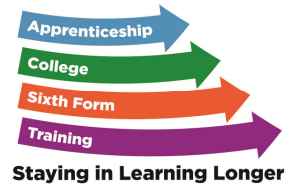
Options are:

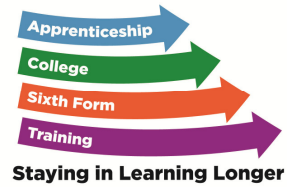

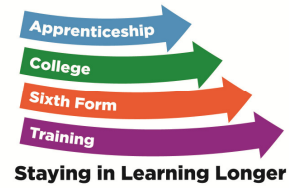

Apprenticeships

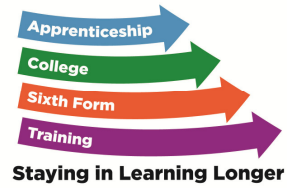
- **New from September 2015**

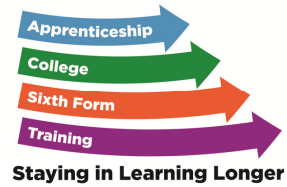

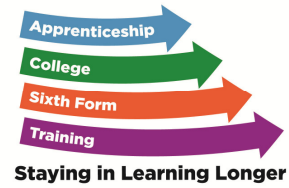

UTC

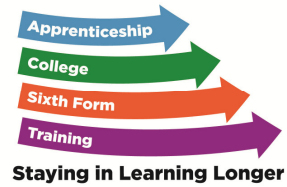
- Bucks University Technical College

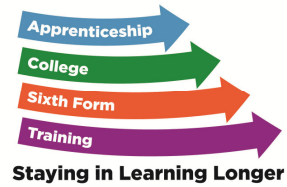

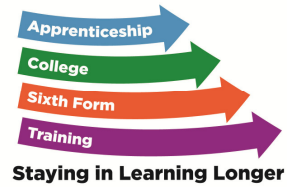
Higher Education

- Research higher education options when looking at Post 16 options



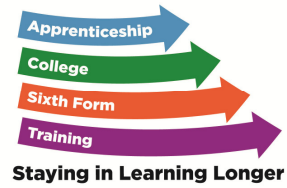
